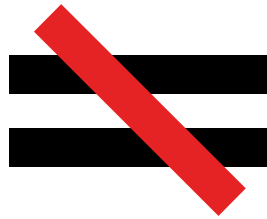
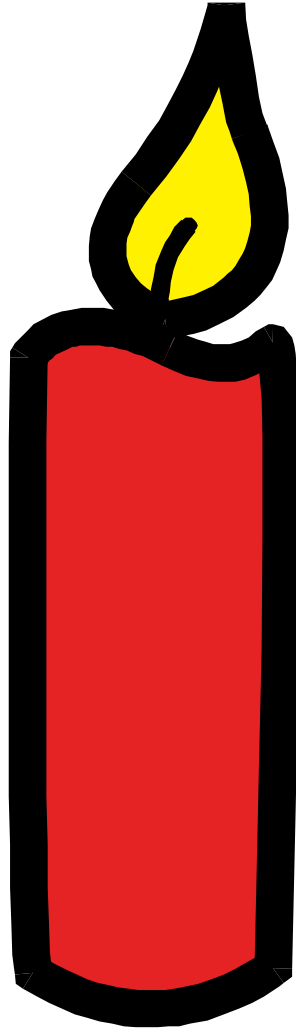


We use Birthday Candles and Chanukkah Candles in Different Ways





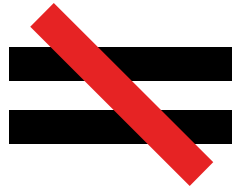
People light candles to celebrate many different happy days.

Another happy time when people light candles is Chanukkah.

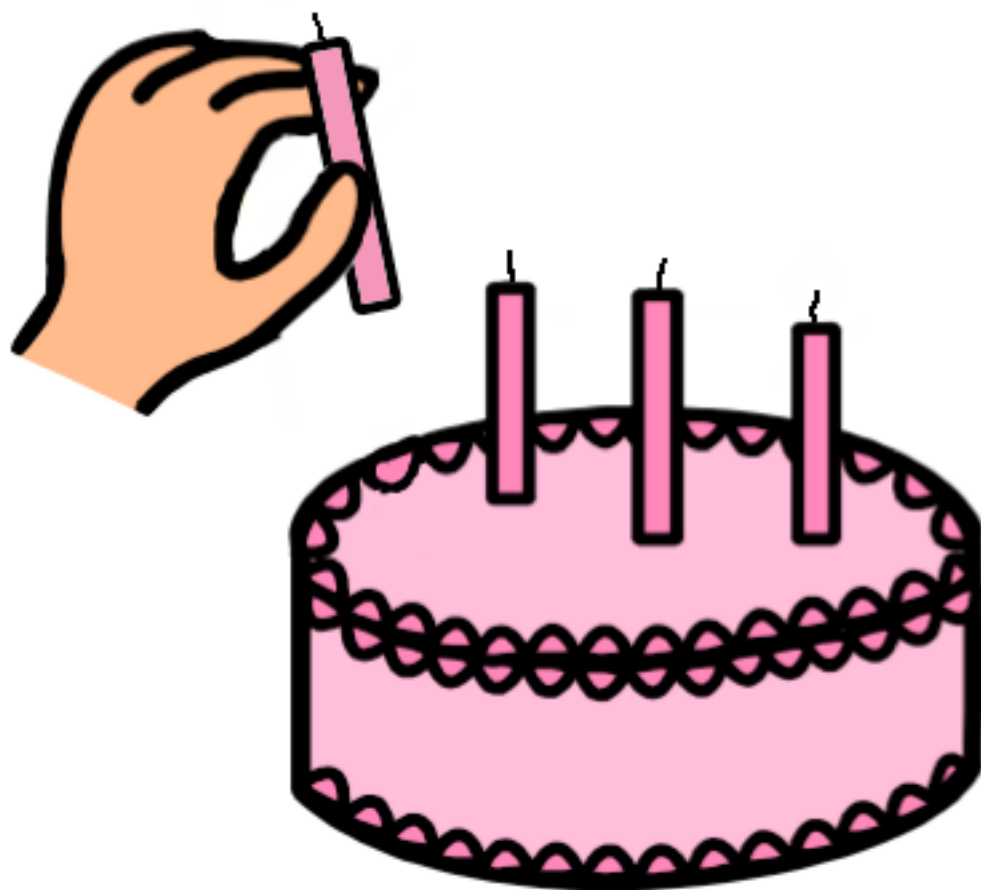


We use birthday candles and Chanukkah candles in different ways.

Adults light birthday candles when I celebrate my birthday.



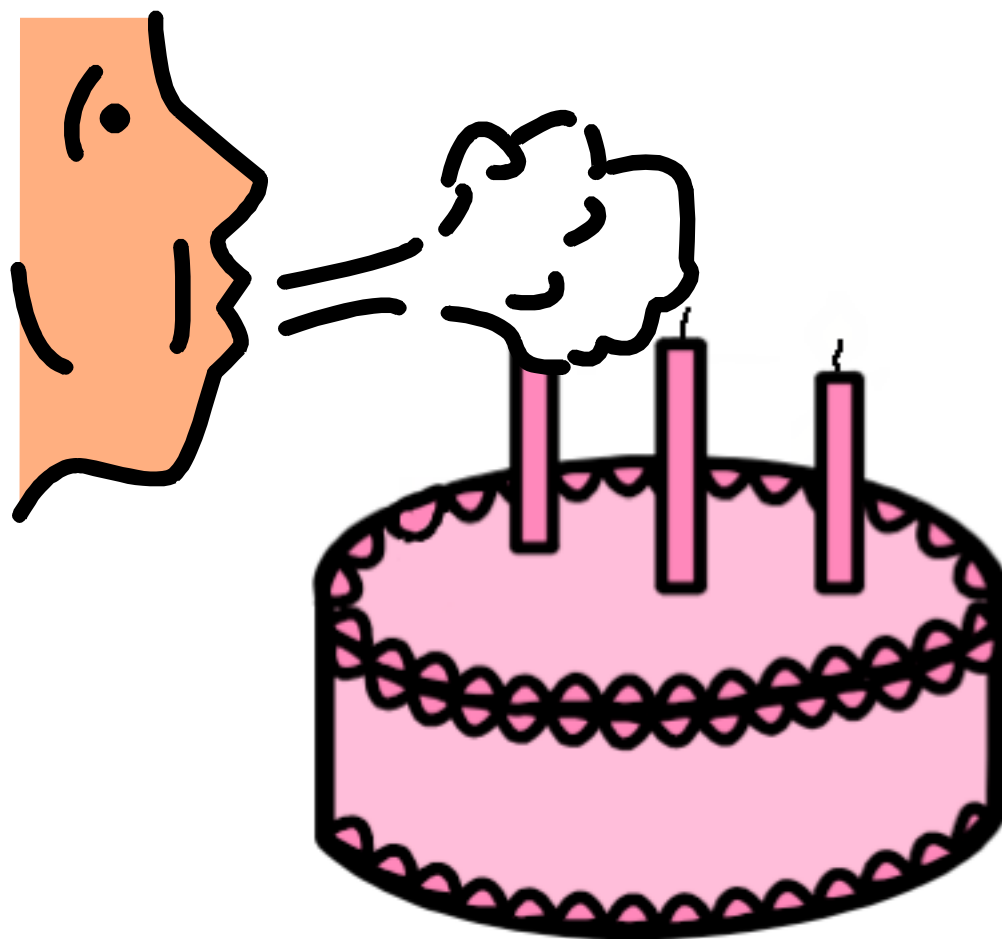
Birthday candles are usually put into a birthday cake.



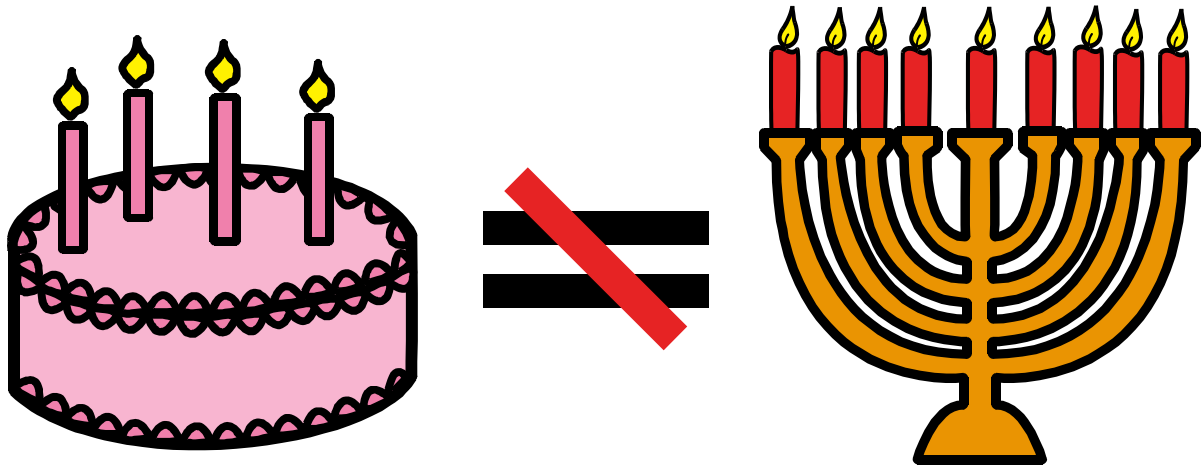
An adult lights the birthday candles with a match or a candle lighter.

Then I get to blow out the birthday candles!



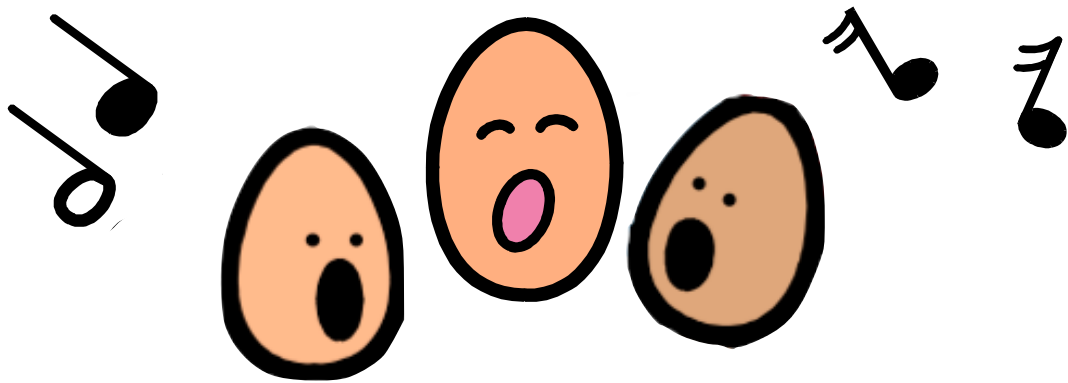
On Chanukkah people light candles, too. But Chanukkah candles are used in a different way than birthday candles.



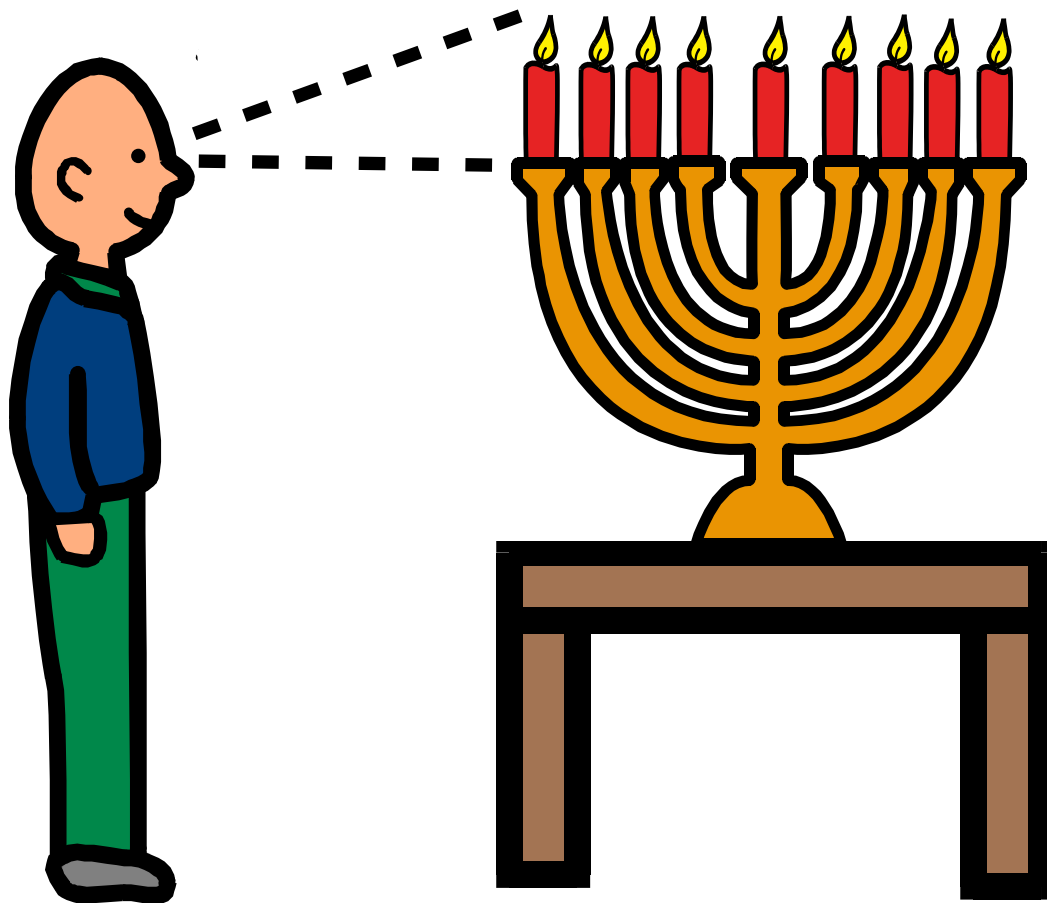
I do not put Chanukkah candles in a cake. I put Chanukkah candles in a menorah.



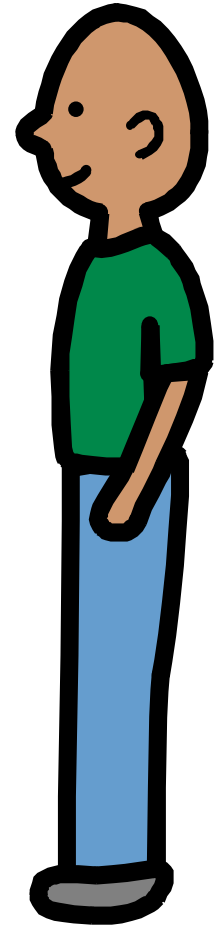
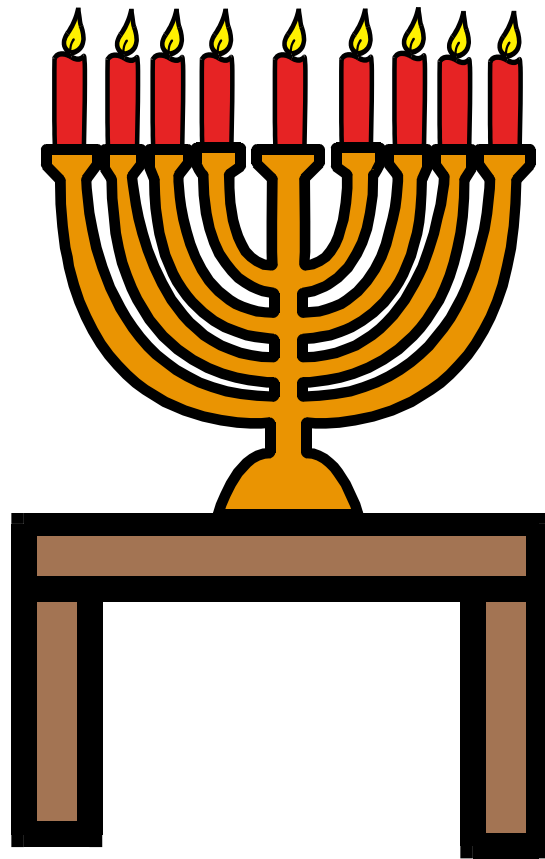
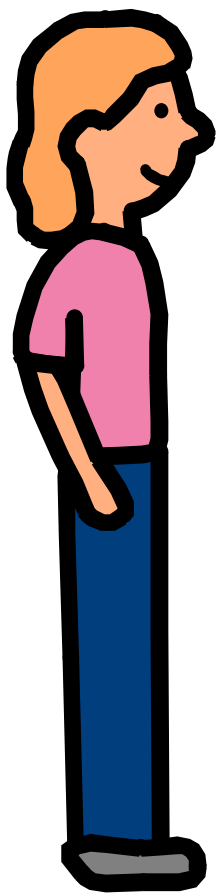
People do not light all of the Chanukkah candles with a match. First, an adult lights one special candle called the shammes using a match or candle lighter. Then I might help use the shammes to light the other Chanukkah candles.



On Chanukkah, people do not sing Happy Birthday. Instead, we sing blessings over the Chanukkah candles.



After we say the blessings, I do not blow out the Chanukkah candles. Instead, I watch the Chanukkah candles as they burn.



Watching the candles is a special thing people do on Chanukkah. The candles help remind people of the Chanukkah story.



Lighting candles is one special way we celebrate happy days!
